80 days. *Abelmoschus esculentus*. Open Pollinated. The plant produces heavy yields of okra. Very easy to grow. The pods are ready to pick when they snap off the stalks easily. Drought-Tolerant. An heirloom variety from San Antonio, Texas, USA.

70 days. *Abelmoschus esculentus*. Open Pollinated. Hill Country Red Okra. The plant produces good yields of 3 to 5" long green and red okra. The pods are green with red tips and red ribs. Great for making fried okra, soups, stews, and gumbo. An excellent pickling variety. Drought Tolerant. Excellent choice for home gardens. An heirloom variety from Texas, USA.
