25 days. Raphanus sativus. Open Pollinated. French Breakfast Radish. This early maturing plant produces excellent yields of 1 ¾ to 2" long radishes. They are red at the top and white at the bottom. Very mild, crispy, and flavorful. Perfect for salads, vegetable platters, gourmet dishes, dips, and garnishes. The flesh is crisp, mild, and flavorful. Very easy to grow. Suitable for hydroponics gardening. Also known as Radis Demi-long Rose Radish and Bout Blanc Radish. An excellent choice for home gardens and specialty market growers.
