PE37-50 - Patio Pride Sweet Pea Seeds

40 days. Pisum sativum. Open Pollinated. Patio Pride Sweet Peas. This early maturing compact plant produces good yields of sweet peas. The peas are sweet and very tender when harvested early. Perfect fresh in salads, in soups, and used in cooking. Suitable for small gardens, raised beds, containers, and patios. It is perfect for succession planting every 2 weeks, so you have fresh peas all year. Easy to grow. Use a trellis for support. An excellent choice for home gardens. A variety from the USA.



PE33-50 - Tom Thumb Sweet Pea Seeds

55 days. Pisum sativum. Open Pollinated. Tom Thumb Sweet Peas. This dwarf plant produces good yields of sweet peas. Perfect fresh in salads, in soups, and used in cooking. Suitable for indoor or outdoor containers. Great for your patio or close to the kitchen. This variety is also suitable for cold frame production and hydroponics gardening. This pea can take temperatures down to 20 F. Also known as Half Pint Pea. An excellent choice for home gardens. An English heirloom variety dating back to 1854.
