1994 All-America Selections Winner! 85 days. *Lavandula angustifolia*. Perennial. Plant produces blue green foliage and very beautiful and aromatic dark purple flowers. An improved compact version that attracts bees. Makes an excellent ornamental hedge. Used in bouquets, sachets and perfumes. The tender stalks are sometimes used in salads. The flowers and leaves are also edible. Used to repel moths, mosquitoes and gnats. Blooms the first year from seed! Suitable for containers. Plant Height: 12" tall. pk/25

**Sunlight:** Full Sun

**Planting Instructions:** Sprinkle seeds on soil.

**Soil Facts:** Requires a well prepared soil. Use general purpose fertilizer when preparing soil. Do not water plants very much.

**Germination:** 12-18 days at 70°F

**Tips:** Use Herbs Alive and RootBlast for larger plants and higher yields.

**Sunlight:** Partial Shade

**Planting Instructions:** Plant seeds ¼" deep.

**Soil Facts:** Requires a well prepared soil. Use general purpose fertilizer when preparing soil.

**Germination:** 12-18 days at 70°F

**Sunlight:** Partial Shade/Full Sun

**Planting Instructions:** Plant seeds ½" deep. Plant every 3 to 4 weeks for continuous supply.

**Soil Facts:** Requires a well prepared soil. Use general purpose fertilizer when preparing soil.

**Germination:** 12-18 days

Plant Height: 18" tall. pk/100

**Sunlight:** Full Sun

**Soil Facts:** Requires a well prepared soil. Use general purpose fertilizer when preparing soil.

**Germination:** 7 - 14 day at 68°F
