82 days. Cucumis melo. Open Pollinated. Honey Rock Melon. The plant produces 5 to 7 lb cantaloupes with gray-green skin. This early variety has a thick and firm deep salmon-orange color flesh that is incredibly sweet and juicy. Great for cooler climate regions. Excellent choice for home gardens. A 1920 heirloom variety was developed by Michigan State University for markets in the Northeastern US and Canada. United States Department of Agriculture, NSL 8516. Disease Resistant: FW.

83 days. Cucumis melo. Open Pollinated. Imperial 45 Melon. The plant produces heavy yields of cantaloupes. They are very sweet and have deep orange flesh. Keeps well. Good shipper. Developed for hot and humid regions. An excellent choice for home gardens and market growers. United States Department of Agriculture, NSL 5683. Disease Resistant: PM.
