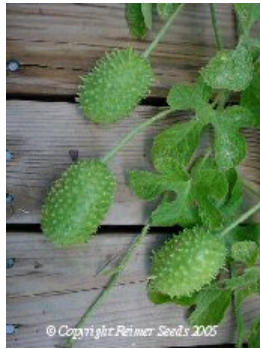

CU33-20 - West India Gherkin Cucumbers

65 days. Cucumis anguria. Plant produces heavy yields of 2" long small cucumbers. Perfect for making tiny sweet pickles! Also cooked and added to soups. This variety has been grown in the country for over 200 years. United States Department of Agriculture, NSL 5769. pk/20



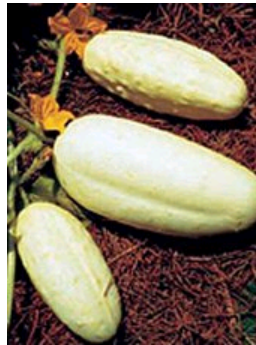
CU47-20 - Vert de Massy Cucumbers

53 days. Cucumis sativus. Plant produces good yields of the very small 4" long cucumbers. This variety is similar to Gherkins. Best when harvested when cucumbers are 4" long or smaller. Excellent for making tiny sweet pickles. Disease Resistant. pk/20



CU58-20 - White Wonder Cucumbers

60 days. Cucumis sativus. Plant produces good yields of 8" long white cucumbers. Excellent for salads, pickles, or gourmet dishes. Impress your neighbors by growing some white cucumbers! United States Department of Agriculture, NSL 5773. pk/20



CU60-20 - Miniature White Cucumbers



48 days. Cucumis sativus. Plant produces high yields of small white cucumbers. One of the best white cucumbers on the market as it has not bitterness which is typical of most white cucumbers. Excellent for salads, pickles, or gourmet dishes. Impress your neighbors by growing some white cucumbers! pk/20

CU62-20 - African Horned Cucumbers

120 days. Cucumis metuliferus. Plant produces good yields of thorny oval fruits that are filled with greenish-gold gel. It has the flavor of pomegranate and citrus. Grown for garnishes and decorative fruits. Excellent gourmet variety sold at specialty markets. Best when grown on trellis. Also known as Kiwano and Jelly Melon. A variety from New Zealand. pk/20



CU64-20 - Bianco Lungo Cucumbers

58 days. Cucumis sativus. Plant produces heavy yields of 9" long shiny white skinned cucumbers. Excellent slicing cucumber which can be used to make dill pickles. A variety from Italy. pk/20



CU79-20 - Mexican Sour Gherkin Cucumbers

50 days. Cucumis anguria. Plant produces heavy yields of 2" long small cucumbers that look like miniature watermelons. They have the sweet cucumber flavor, followed by a surprising sourness, which leads you to believe they are already pickled! Perfect for making tiny sweet pickles! They fall off the vines when ripe. Should use trellises when growing this variety. pk/20



CU83-20 - Boothby's Blonde Cucumbers



65 days. Cucumis sativus. Plant produces high yields of small 4" to 8" long creamy yellow cucumbers. The cucumbers are sweet and crunchy. Can be used fresh in salads or used to make wonderful sweet pickles. A heirloom variety from the Boothby family in Livermore, Maine. Excellent variety for home gardens or market growers. pk/20
