**PM16-10 - Rouge Vif d Etampes Pumpkins**



100 days. Cucurbita pepo. Plant produces good yields of 20 lb size bright reddish-orange pumpkins. Pumpkins are flattened globe shaped with deep ribs. Keeps well. A heirloom variety from France. pk/10

**PM50-10 - Musquee de Provence Pumpkins**



80 days. Cucurbita pepo. Plant produces good yields of 10 lb smooth orange pumpkins. This pumpkin is used by chefs around the world and can be found on menus of the best restaurants. It has orange flesh that is very sweet and flavorful. This variety keeps well throughout all the winter. Also known as Muscat de Provence. This heirloom pumpkin is from southern France. pk/10

**PM26-10 - Cinderella Pumpkins**



110 days. Cucurbita maxima. Plant produces 25 lb reddish orange pumpkins. This pumpkin has delicious flesh. This pumpkin looks just like the coach in the fairy tale Cinderella. Excellent for carving or making pumpkin pie. A heirloom variety from France. pk/10

**PM52-10 - Yellow of Paris Pumpkins**

80 days. Cucurbita pepo. Plant produces good yields of very large yellow pumpkins. This pumpkin is very popular in Paris and can grow up to 100 lbs. It is very sweet and flavorful. Also known as Jaune Gros De Paris. A variety from France. pk/10
