PM10-10 - New England Pie Pumpkins

105 days. Cucurbita pepo. Plant produces 4 to 7 lb dark orange pumpkins. The flesh is dry and stringless, making it one of the best for pumpkin pies. A good variety for the home garden. pk/10



PM13-10 - Frosty Pumpkins

F-1 Hybrid Variety

95 days. Cucurbita pepo. (F1) Bush type plant produces good yields of orange pumpkins. Perfect Halloween pumpkins for pies or Jack-O-Lanterns. Suitable or small home gardens. pk/10



PM21-10 - Baby Pam Pumpkins

105 days. Cucurbita pepo. Plant produces small 4 lb deep orange pumpkins. This is a bright deep orange pumpkin with a thick handle. Excellent for decoration and one of the finest varieties for making pumpkin pies. pk/10



PM24-10 - Snack Jack Pumpkins

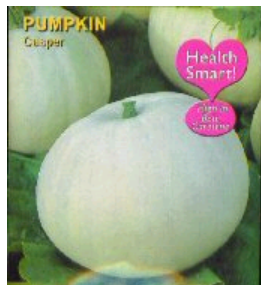
F-1 Hybrid Variety

90 days. Cucurbita pepo. (F1) Bush type plant produces good yields of orange pumpkins that have very flavorful seeds. Just wash and roast the seeds for a great snack. Perfect for making pumpkin pies and carving. pk/10



PM30-10 - Casper Pumpkins

115 days. Cucurbita pepo. Plant produces good yields of 15 pound white pumpkins. The flesh is sweet making it perfect for baking or pies. Excellent for for carving or painting. Grow gray and orange pumpkins too for a colorful decorative Halloween display. pk/10



PM39-10 - Aspen Pumpkins

F-1 Hybrid Variety

90 days. (F1) Cucurbita moschata. Semi-bush plant produces good yields of 20 lb deep orange pumpkins. This very attractive pumpkins has large and sturdy handles. This variety stores and ships well. pk/10



PM11-10 - Small Sugar Pumpkins



Heirloom Variety

95 days. Cucurbita pepo. Plant produces good yields of 10" diameter bright orange yellow pumpkin. It is a smaller version of the Connecticut Field. One of the best pumpkin for making pumpkin pies! An early heirloom pumpkin grown in 1887. United States Department of Agriculture, NSL 20182. pk/10

PM19-10 - Ghost Rider Pumpkins PVP



PVP Variety

115 days. Cucurbita pepo. Plant produces good yields of 20 lb dark orange pumpkins. The orange-yellow flesh is sweet, dry, and stringless making it perfect for baking or pies. This variety will store for months. Grow white, gray, and orange pumpkins too for a colorful decorative Halloween display. pk/10

PVP Variety - Seeds may be used only to grow for personal use.

PM23-10 - Spookie Pumpkins

90 days. Cucurbita pepo. Plant produces heavy yields of 7" across bright orange pumpkins. It has strong stems. Very flavorful flesh perfect for Pumpkin pies. Easy to carve. High yields makes it suitable for market growers. United States Department of Agriculture, NSL 42999. pk/10



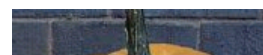
PM26-10 - Cinderella Pumpkins



Heirloom Variety

110 days. Cucurbita maxima. Plant produces 25 lb reddish orange pumpkins. This pumpkin has delicious flesh. This pumpkin looks just like the coach in the fairy tale Cinderella. Excellent for carving or making pumpkin pie. A heirloom variety from France. pk/10

PM3-10 - Connecticut Field Pumpkins





Heirloom Variety

120 days. Cucurbita moschata. Plant produces good yields of 15 to 25 lb deep orange yellow pumpkins. It is the original Halloween pumpkin! Excellent for making pumpkin pie. A heirloom pumpkin grown by the first settlers in New England. United States Department of Agriculture, NSL 9365. pk/10

PM7-10 - Jack O Lantern Pumpkins

100 days. Cucurbita pepo. Plant produces medium size 10 lb orange Halloween pumpkins. Excellent for pumpkin pies and making Jack O Lantern curved pumpkins. Kids love them! pk/10
