



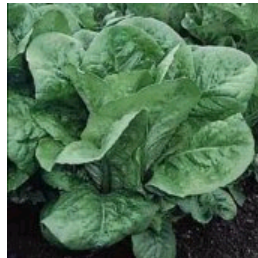

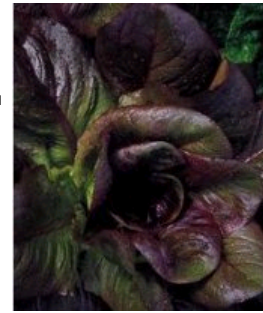
### LC10- 100 - Dark Green Cos Lettuce

70 days. Lactuca sativa. Plant produces flavorful dark green heads of romaine lettuce. Leaves are loosely folded on heads. Excellent for salads and garnishes. United States Department of Agriculture, PI 543966. pk/100



### LC11- 100 - Cimmaron Red Romaine Lettuce

60 days. Lactuca sativa. Plant produces a beautiful red Romaine that produces 10 to 12 inch bronze-red heads with a green heart. Leaves are loosely folded on heads. Excellent for salads and garnishes. One of the slowest to bolt lettuce on the market. Good for spring, summer and fall planting as it's cold-hardy and also tolerates heat. Grown in the US since the 18th century. pk/100



### LC13- 100 - Tom Thumb Lettuce

65 days. Lactuca sativa. Small compact plant produces flavorful butterhead lettuce. Excellent for salads and garnishes. Suitable for greenhouse. United States Department of Agriculture, PI 536767. pk/100



### LC31- 100 - Parris Island Cos Lettuce

72 days. Lactuca sativa. Plant produces flavorful dark green heads of lettuce. Leaves are loosely folded on heads. Excellent for salads and garnishes. Excellent for Caesar salads. pk/100



### LC32- 100 - Green Forest Lettuce

56 days. Lactuca sativa. Plant produces long, broad, upright dark green Paris Island type lettuce. Excellent for salads and garnishes. This is a slow bolting variety. pk/100



### LC50- 100 - Little Gem Lettuce

70 days. Lactuca sativa. Plant produces good yields of 5" dark green romaine lettuce. This refined variety has superb flavor and can be served whole. The heads are tightly wrapped and are sweet and crunchy. A heat tolerant variety. pk/100



### LC51- 100 - Red Romana Lettuce

70 days. Lactuca sativa. Plant produces good yields of green romaine lettuce with red tips. A great variety for gourmet dishes or used as a garnish. pk/100



### LC52- 100 - Winter Density Lettuce

65 days. Lactuca sativa. Plant produces heavy yields of 10" dark green romaine lettuce. Leaves are tightly folded and have a sweet flavor. Suitable for summer and winter plantings. A slow to bolt variety that can tolerate light frost. pk/100



### LC57- 100 - Freckles Lettuce

70 days. Lactuca sativa. Plant produces flavorful green heads of romaine lettuce splashed with red speckles. Excellent for salads and garnishes. A heirloom variety. pk/100



### LC58- 100 - Petite Rouge Lettuce

**NEW** 70 days. Lactuca sativa. Plant produces true baby heads of red romaine lettuce. Easy to grow and adapted to most climates. Excellent for salads and garnishes. pk/100
