**CA21-20 - Jenny Lind Muskmelons**



**Heirloom. Variety**

75 days. Cucumis melo. Plant produces good yields of turban shaped muskmelons. The lime green flesh is juicy and delightfully sweet. A heirloom variety known in the Philadelphia markets before 1840 and was named after a popular singer of that era. Disease Resistant. pk/20

**CA36-20 - Banana Melons**

90 days. Cucumis melo. Plant produces good yields of 18" long yellow melons. The orange flesh is very juicy and has a banana flavor. United States Department of Agriculture, NSL 2888. pk/20



**CA62-20 - Healy's Pride Melons**



**Heirloom. Variety**

85 days. Cucumis melo. Plant produces good yields of 10 lb size sweet muskmelons. This heavily netted melon has the sweet old-time muskmelon flavor. An heirloom variety dating back to 1952 from Elmer James Healy of Saint Francisville, IL, USA. pk/20

**CA32-20 - Charlynne Muskmelons**

90 days. Cucumis melo. Plant produces good yields of 4 lb size melons. This oval shaped fruits has fine exterior netting and turn light orange when ripe. The white flesh is creamy, sweet, aromatic, soft, and juicy. A variety from the Mediterranean Sea region. Excellent for home garden and market growers. pk/20



**CA51-20 - Minnesota Midget Melons**

100 days. Cucumis melo. Plant produces good yields of 3 lb melons. The melons are purple-red on top and light green underneath. It has a golden yellow flesh with high sugar content. Plant has 3 ft vines. pk/20
