OK11-20 - Star of David Okra



75 days. *Abelmoschus esculentus*. This variety produces heavy yields of 6" long by 1 1/2" wide green okra as long as plant is kept well picked. Best to harvest when 3" long. Named because cross sections of the pods look like the Star of David. A heirloom variety from Hyde County, North Carolina, USA. Plant Height: 7 ft tall. pk/20

OK23-10 - Beck's Gardenville Okra



NEW 80 days. *Abelmoschus esculentus*. Plant produces heavy yields of okra. Easy to grow. The pods are ready to pick when they snap off the stalks easily. A drought tolerant plant. A heirloom variety from San Antonio, Texas, USA. pk/10

OK27-20 - Red Velvet Okra

70 days. *Abelmoschus esculentus*. Plant produces good yields of beautiful 5" long scarlet red okra. This variety has deep red colored stems with green leaves. Best when harvested when pods are 3" to 5" long when still tender. Height: 5 ft tall. pk/20



OK29-10 - Jimmy T's Okra



NEW 65 days. *Abelmoschus esculentus*. Plant produces heavy yields of okra. Easy to grow. A heirloom variety grown by Jimmy T Morris of Kentucky, USA, since the 1940's. plant Height: 48" tall. pk/10

OK2-20 - Red Burgundy Okra



1988 All-America Selections Winner! 60 days. *Abelmoschus esculentus*. Plant produces good yields of burgundy colored okra. This variety has deep red colored stems with green leaves. Pods can be harvested up to 8" long and still remain tender. Developed by Leon Robbins, Clemson University, SC, USA. Plant Height: 48" tall. pk/20

OK24-20 - Clemson Spineless 80 Okra

55 days. *Abelmoschus esculentus*. Plant produces high yields of flavorful medium green okra. Leaves are spineless making it easier to harvest. Taller and more open than the Clemson Spineless Okra. Best if picked when 3" long. Used for soups, stews, and meats dishes. Developed by Clemson University, SC, USA. Plant Height: 60" tall. pk/20

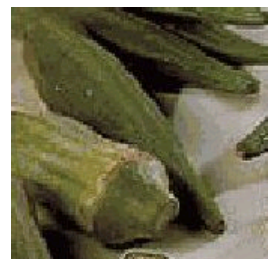


OK28-20 - Mammoth Okra

65 days. *Abelmoschus esculentus*. Plant produces high yields of large green okra. This variety has green stems with green leaves. Best when harvested when pods are 5" long when still tender. Height: 6 ft tall. pk/20



OK3-20 - Louisiana Green Velvet Okra



1941 All-America Selections Winner! 58 days. *Abelmoschus esculentus*. Plant produces good yields of 8" long spineless dark green okra. The okra remain tender when large. This variety does well where temperatures and humidity are high. United States Department of Agriculture, NSL 22639. A variety from the Louisiana State University, Louisiana, USA. Plant Height: 48" tall. pk/20
