SP123-10 - Spanish Paprika Sweet Peppers

85 days. Capsicum annuum. Plant produces good yields of 2 ¼" long by 2" wide sweet peppers. Peppers turn from green to dark red when mature. They have just a touch of heat. The best paprika is made from peppers from Spain. Suitable for home garden and market growers. United States Department of Agriculture, PI 298646. A variety from Spain. Plant Height: 33". pk/10

SP166-20 - Yellow Paprika Sweet Peppers

90 days. Capsicum annuum. Plant produces good yields of 1" long by 1" wide sweet peppers. Peppers grow upright and turn from green to yellow when mature. Plant has green stems, green leaves, and white flowers. A variety from the USA. pk/20



SP222-10 - Hungarian Spice Paprika Sweet Peppers

F-1 Hybrid Variety

NEW 80 days. Capsicum annuum. (F1) Plant produces heavy yields of 6" long by 1 ½" wide sweet peppers. Peppers turn from green to red when mature. Excellent for making Hungarian Paprika. pk/10



SP51-10 - Paprika Supreme Sweet Peppers

F-1 Hybrid Variety

85 days. Capsicum annuum. (F1) Plant produces heavy yields of 8" long by 1 ½" wide sweet peppers. Peppers turn from green to dark red when mature. A specialty pepper which is dried, crushed, and ground into dark red paprika powder. Can also be used fresh. One of the highest yielding Paprika varieties on the market. Suitable for home garden and market growers. pk/10



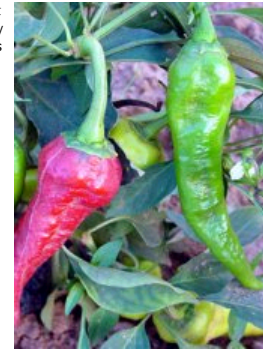
SP155-20 - NuMex Sweet Peppers

90 days. Capsicum annuum. Plant produces good yields of sweet peppers. Peppers are sweet and turn from green to dark red when mature. Excellent for making dark red paprika powder. A variety from New Mexico, USA. pk/20



SP170-20 - Dolga Sweet Peppers

85 days. Capsicum annuum. Plant produces good yields of 4" long by 1 ¼" wide sweet peppers. Peppers turn from green to red when mature. Plant has green stems, green leaves, and white flowers. Used to make Paprika. United States Department of Agriculture, PI 370374. A variety from Macedonia. pk/20



SP37-10 - Kalocsa Sweet Peppers

85 days. Capsicum annuum. Plant produces good yields of 6 ½" long by 1 ¼" wide sweet peppers. Peppers turn from green to dark red when mature. Plant has green stems, green leaves, and white flowers. Excellent for making a high quality Hungarian Paprika. Pepper is named after the famous Paprika City in Kalocs, Hungary. pk/10



SP95-20 - Tennessee Cheese Sweet Peppers



Heirloom Variety

82 days. Capsicum annuum. Plant produces good yields of apple or tomato shaped sweet peppers. Peppers have thick walls and turn from green to red when mature. Excellent for making high quality paprika, stuffing and pickling. A heirloom variety from a family of Kingston, Tennessee, USA. A variety originally from Spain. pk/20
