50 days. Solanum melongena. (F1) This early maturing plant produces good yields of 2 to 4" long lavender eggplants with white stripes. It has a delicious creamy flavor and no bitter taste. Perfect for growing in containers. An excellent choice for home gardens and specialty market growers.

55 days. Solanum melongena. (F1) This early maturing plant produces high yields of 3 to 10" long shiny dark purple eggplants. It is non-bitter and perfect for slicing thin onto pizza, casseroles, grilling, or stuffing. This variety is perfect for gourmet dishes. With most eggplants, you must remove the glossy purple skin to dispose of the bad taste, but not so with this variety. They are tender and non-bitter. Best when harvested when 2 to 4" long. It has very few seeds. Grows extremely well in containers. Excellent choice for home gardens.

50 days. *Solanum melongena*. (F1) Patio Baby Eggplant. This early maturing compact plant produces good yields of small 3" long dark glossy purple eggplants. The eggplants are thin-skinned, tender, and very flavorful. Perfect size for a single serving. Excellent grilled or roasted. This small plant is perfect for balconies, patios, and urban farming operations. Suitable for containers. An excellent choice for home gardens. A variety from the USA.
