RD31-50 - Philadelphia White Box Radishes



30 days. Raphanus sativus. Plant produces nice and mild round white radishes. An historic radish from the 1890s. The D. Landreth Seed Company, the oldest seed house in the US which was established in 1784, listed this variety in their seed list. Suitable for home garden and market growers. A heirloom variety from the USA. pk/50

RD45-50 - Lady Slipper Radishes

27 days. Raphanus sativus. Plant produces a charming bright pink elongated radish. The radishes are crisp, sweet, and mild. Stays tender and crispy even in cold weather. pk/50



RD47-50 - Rudolf Radishes

25 days. Raphanus sativus. Plant produces a dark red globe shaped radishes. The radishes are crisp, sweet, and mild. Stays tender and crispy. You can grow this variety all season long. Suitable for outdoor crops as well as growing in greenhouses. High tolerance to cracking. Disease Resistant. pk/50



RD41-50 - Misato Rose Radishes

F-1 Hybrid Variety

65 days. Raphanus sativus. Plant produces 2" diameter white radishes with pink interior. The radishes are crisp and sweet. Stays tender and crispy even in cold weather. A good keeper after harvest. For late summer or early fall sowing. pk/50

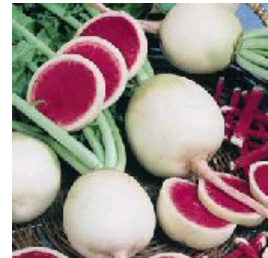


RD46-50 - Miyashige Radishes

NEW 60 days. Raphanus sativus. Plant produces a 15" long by 2" wide radish. The radishes are sweet and used in Oriental dishes. A favorite Japanese variety. pk/50



RD48-50 - Watermelon Radishes



24 days. Raphanus sativus. Plant produces a very large white radish with pink and red flesh. Excellent for gourmet dishes. They have large tops for easy picking. Also known as Red Meat Radish. A heirloom variety. pk/50
