ST1-25 - Sarian Strawberry

Fragaria spp. Plant produces excellent yields of juicy deep red strawberries from seeds the very first year! Excellent winter hardy plants, just mulch during winter. This variety grows well in containers and hanging baskets too! A variety that is tolerant to fruit rot and powdery mildew. Kids love them! Excellent gift for Valentine Day. pk/25

Planting Instructions: Sprinkle seeds thinly in March or April in a fine seed starting soilless mix.

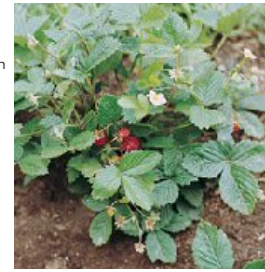
Soil Facts: Requires a well prepared soil. Use general purpose fertilizer when preparing soil.

ST2-100 - Alexandria Strawberry

Fragaria vesca. Plant produces excellent yields of juicy bright red strawberries from seeds the very first year if started early enough in the spring. This variety does not produce runners and can be planted with vegetables and flowers. The leaves make excellent herbal tea with woodruff leaves. Suitable for containers, rock gardens, and edging plants. Kids love them! pk/100
