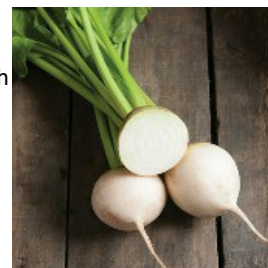
[BT6-50 - Albino Beets](#)

50 days. Beta vulgaris. Open Pollinated. Plant produces high yields of very sweet white beets. Excellent flavor Beets can grow quite large without becoming bitter. Beets are white and will never stain again! This gourmet beet is ideal for boiling, pickling, baking, and freezing. Excellent choice for home gardens.



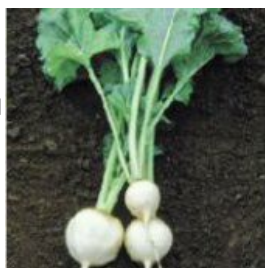
[BT32-50 - Avalanche Beets](#)

2015 All-America Selections Winner! 50 days. Beta vulgaris. (F1) Plant produces high yields of very sweet pure white beets. Excellent flavor, very mild. Beets can grow quite large without becoming bitter. Beets are white and will never stain again! This gourmet beet is ideal for boiling, pickling, baking, and freezing. Excellent choice for home gardens and market growers. Disease Resistant: CLS.



[BT3-50 - Blankoma Beets](#)

55 days. Beta vulgaris. Open Pollinated. Plant produces large white beets. Leaves can be eaten as greens. Roots are white and are ideal for boiling, pickling, baking, and freezing. Perfect for gourmet dishes. Excellent choice for home gardens and market growers.



[BT20-50 - Boltardy Beets](#)

56 days. Beta vulgaris. Open Pollinated. Plant produces good yields of large deep crimson round beets. They are ideal pickled with vinegar or used fresh in salads! This is one of the most popular beet varieties in England. Excellent choice for home gardens. United States Department of Agriculture, PI 612340.



[BT13-50 - Bull's Blood Beets](#)

55 days. Beta vulgaris. Open Pollinated. Plant produces good yields of large sweet dark red beets. Dark reddish purple leaves can be used as an addition to mesclun mixes. Roots are dark red and are perfect for canning. Also ideal for boiling, pickling, baking, and freezing. Excellent choice for home gardens. United States Department of Agriculture, W6 44528.



[BT14-50 - Burpee's Golden Beets](#)

55 days. Beta vulgaris. Open Pollinated. Plant produces good yields of large bright golden beets. Best when harvested when small, but will not become fibrous when large. Leaves can be eaten as greens. Excellent choice for home gardens.



[BT1-50 - Chioggia Beets](#)

60 days. Beta vulgaris. Open Pollinated. Plant produces good yields of very sweet pink skinned beet. Beets have red and white circular rings in interior. Ideal for boiling, pickling, baking, and freezing. Leaves can be used as greens. Excellent choice for home gardens. A heirloom variety introduced to the United States in 1840's from Italy.



[BT31-50 - Chioggia Guardsmark Beets](#)

60 days. Beta vulgaris. Open Pollinated. Plant produces good yields of very sweet pink skinned beet. Beets have red and white circular rings in interior. This is the improved version of the Chioggia beet. It has better skin color, candy striping, and is tolerant to bolting. Ideal for boiling, pickling, baking, and freezing. Leaves can be used as greens. Excellent choice for home gardens.

[MG1-50 - Colossal Long Red Mangels](#)

110 days. Beta vulgaris. Open Pollinated. Plant produces giant 24" long beets weighing up to 15 lbs. Contains less water and more sugar than any other variety. These giant beets are valuable winter feed for sheep, poultry and cattle. Excellent choice for home gardens.



[BT21-50 - Crimson Globe Beets](#)

56 days. Beta vulgaris. Open Pollinated. Plant produces good yields of large rich maroon globe shaped beets. An improved Detroit Dark Red version beet that is ideal for successional sowing. Excellent choice for home gardens. United States Department of Agriculture, PI 92140.



[BT2-50 - Crosby's Egyptian Beets](#)

55 days. Beta vulgaris. Open Pollinated. Plant produces good yields of purplish-red beet. Ideal for boiling, pickling, baking, and freezing. This smooth round flat shaped beet is one of the best beets on the market. Excellent choice for home gardens and market growers. An 1860s heirloom variety from the Germany. United States Department of Agriculture, PI 590617.



[BT12-50 - Cylindra Beets](#)

60 days. Beta vulgaris. Open Pollinated. Plant produces good yields of high quality 8" long by 2" wide carrot shaped beets. Beets are very sweet and have dark red flesh. Excellent canning variety. Excellent choice for home gardens. United States Department of Agriculture, NSL 31342.



[BT5-50 - Detroit Dark Red Beets](#)

65 days. Beta vulgaris. Open Pollinated. Plant produces good yields of exceptional quality 3" diameter dark red globe shaped beets. One of the best beets on the market. Ideal for boiling, pickling, canning, baking, and freezing. Excellent storage variety. Excellent choice for home gardens. United States Department of Agriculture, PI 590605. Disease Resistant: DM.



[BT10-50 - Detroit Dark Red Beets \(Morse's Strain\)](#)

65 days. Beta vulgaris. Open Pollinated. Plant produces good yields of exceptional quality 3" diameter dark red globe shaped beets. The green tops can be boiled and used as greens. Ideal for boiling, pickling, canning, baking, and freezing. Excellent choice for home gardens. This is a strain introduced by Ferry-Morse. Disease Resistant: DM.



[BT25-50 - Detroit Supreme Beets](#)

60 days. Beta vulgaris. Open Pollinated. Plant produces good yields of dark red beets. This is an improved version of the Detroit Dark Red Beets with higher yields. The globe shaped beet has blood red flesh. The beets do not get woody, so perfect for canning and pickling. The glossy green medium tops make tangy boiling greens. It will grow even under adverse weather conditions, even in hot weather. Perfect for salads and pickling. Developed by Alf Christianson Seed Company. It has mildew resistance. Excellent choice for home gardens and market growers.



[BT4-50 - Early Wonder Beets](#)

55 days. Beta vulgaris. Open Pollinated. Plant produces good yields of crimson red beets. Ideal for boiling, pickling, baking, and freezing. Also tops can be used as beet greens. Suitable for container gardening. Excellent choice for home gardens. United States Department of Agriculture, PI 92180.



BT22-50 - Golden Detroit Beets

55 days. Beta vulgaris. Open Pollinated. Plant produces good yields of large orange round shaped beets. The beets turn deep yellow when cooked, and do not bleed like red beets. The roots retain their sweet flavor during cooking! The green leaves with yellow stems can be used in salads when young and can be cooked as greens when mature. Excellent choice for home gardens.



BT27-50 - Green Top Bunching Beets

52 days. Beta vulgaris. Open Pollinated. Plant produces good yields of bright red beets. A good quality variety suitable for slicing and dicing. Excellent choice for home gardens and market growers. United States Department of Agriculture, NSL 6323.



BT16-50 - Kestral Beets

53 days. Beta vulgaris. (F1) Plant produces good yields of red beets. A dual purpose variety. It can be harvested early for baby beets, or it can be left in the field to mature to full size. Excellent choice for home gardens. Disease Resistant: CLS, DM, PM, RZ.



BT24-50 - Little Chicago Beets

53 days. Beta vulgaris. (F1) Plant produces good yields of 1 1/2" diameter baby red beets. This small baby beet is very delicious. Perfect for salads and pickling. Excellent choice for home gardens.



BT9-50 - Long Season Lutz Beets

80 days. Beta vulgaris. Open Pollinated. Plant produces good yields of very large sweet dark red beets. Whether the beets are young or old, small or large, they remain tender all summer and fall and keep in fine condition all winter too. Excellent choice for home gardens.



BT28-50 - Merlin Beets

55 days. Beta vulgaris. (F1) Plant produces good yields of dark red beets. The roots are round and smooth and is slow bolting. It has bright red stems and dark green tops. Drought tolerant. Excellent choice for home gardens. Disease Resistance: CLS, DM.



BT29-50 - Pablo Baby Beets

45 days. Beta vulgaris. (F1) Plant produces good yields of baby beets. The plant has deep red roots. Excellent for processing or fresh use. Suitable for pickling. It is recognized as the leading baby beet on the European market! Excellent choice for home gardens and market growers.



BT19-50 - Pacemaker III Beets

53 days. Beta vulgaris. (F1) Plant produces good yields of medium size smooth round red beets. The tall tops are glossy medium green color which makes an attractive addition to mesclun mixes. The globe shaped roots are blood red in color and have excellent flavor. The green tops can be boiled and used as greens. Ideal for boiling, pickling, canning, baking, and freezing. A late bolting variety with excellent flavor. An excellent processing variety for open field production. Excellent choice for home gardens and market growers. Drought Tolerant. Disease Resistant: CLS, PM, RZ.





BT18-50 - Perfected Detroit Beets

58 days. Beta vulgaris. Open Pollinated. Plant produces good yields of exceptional quality 3" diameter dark red globe shaped beets. Same great flavor and canning and pickling qualities as the Detroit Dark Red Beet, but more uniform. One of the best beets on the market. Ideal for boiling, pickling, canning, baking, and freezing. Green tops are delicious too. Excellent storage variety. Excellent choice for home gardens. United States Department of Agriculture, AMES 18472.



BT15-50 - Piatta D'Egitto Beets

55 days. Beta vulgaris. Open Pollinated. Plant produces good yields of red beets. Plant has dark green leaves. Ideal for boiling, pickling, baking, and freezing. Excellent choice for home gardens.



BT26-50 - Red Ace Beets

43 days. Beta vulgaris. (F1) Plant produces good yields of red beets. A good quality variety suitable for slicing, dicing and whole baby beets. The roots are extremely tender, sweet and smooth with up to 50 percent higher red pigment than standard beets and no interior zoning. It has bright green glossy tops. It also has excellent overall disease resistance. Excellent choice for home gardens and market growers.



BT11-50 - Ruby Queen Beets

1957 All-America Selections Winner! 57 days. Beta vulgaris. Open Pollinated. Plant produces good yields of exceptionally super sweet dark red beets. Ideal for boiling, pickling, baking, and freezing. Holds color when canning. Excellent choice for home gardens. United States Department of Agriculture, NSL 6314.



BT7-50 - Sugar Beets

110 days. Open Pollinated. Plant produces good yields of large 3 lb sugar beets. Roots have a sugar flavor. Shred the beets and add to other vegetables. Also used to make molasses and wine. Excellent choice for home gardens and market growers.



BT23-50 - White Detroit Beets

55 days. Beta vulgaris. Open Pollinated. Plant produces good yields of large white beets. The beets are very flavorful. The roots retain their sweet flavor during cooking! Perfect for gourmet dishes. Excellent choice for home gardens.



BT17-50 - Yellow Detroit Beets

60 days. Beta vulgaris. Open Pollinated. Plant produces good yields of exceptional quality yellow beets. The round orange roots turn golden yellow when cooked. One of the best yellow beets on the market. Ideal for boiling, pickling, canning, baking, and freezing. Excellent storage variety. Excellent choice for home gardens.
