CL2-100 - Golden Self Blanching Celery

85 days. Apium graveolens. Plant grows good quality celery. Stalks are thick and heavy, but no strings. One of the best varieties around. United States Department of Agriculture, PI 385950. A variety from Kenya. Disease Resistant. Plant Height: 30" tall. pk/100



CL3-100 - Tall Utah 52-70R Improved Celery

120 days. Apium graveolens. Plant produces high quality tender crisp 11" tall stalks of celery. Excellent for celery sticks or salads! Disease Resistant: Brown Check, Western Celery Mosaic. Plant Height: 30" tall. pk/100



CL4-100 - Giant Pascal Celery

125 days. Apium graveolens. Plant produces jumbo size celery. This variety is easy to blanch. A dozen stalks trimmed for market weight 10 to 15 lbs. Suitable for home garden or market growers. United States Department of Agriculture, NSL 34671. pk/100



CL7-100 - Tendercrisp Celery

112 days. Apium graveolens. Plant grows extra large celery. It is crispy and crunchy. The stalks are crowned with very tasty green leaves. Great when used in salads and soups. Plant Height: 36" tall. pk/100



HB30-100 - Cutting Celery

85 days. Apium graveolens. Annual. Plant produces very flavorful leaves used fresh in salads, soups, stews, and mixed vegetables. Also great when making tomato juice. Cutting celery is easy to grow! Suitable for containers. pk/100
