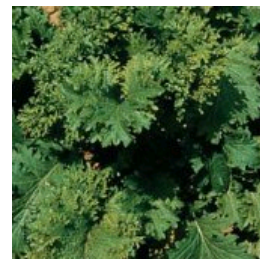

48 days. Brassica juncea. Plant produces good yields of flavorful medium dark green mustard leaves. Excellent greens used in salads or cooked. Harvest promptly and often, as this is an early bolting mustard green. pk/100



MU1-100 - Southern Giant Curled Mustard



MU2-100 - Florida Broad Leaf Mustard

48 days. Brassica juncea. Plant produces good yields of flavorful green mustard leaves. Excellent greens used in salads, sandwiches, or cooked. This variety bolts slower than other varieties. High in Vitamin A, B, and C. Excellent freezing and canning variety. A traditional Southern favorite. Plant Height: 24". pk/100

64 days. Brassica juncea. Plant produces good yields of flavorful mustard leaves. A Japanese mustard with large thick and tender leaves with white ribs. The have purple-red leaves on the top and light green underneath. Excellent greens used in salads or cooked. Slow to bolt. Very winter hardy. Plant Height: 24" tall. pk/100

35 days. Brassica juncea. Plant produces good yields of green mustard leaves. Very flavorful. A traditional Southern favorite. pk/100

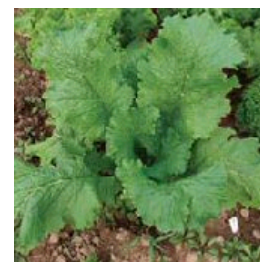


MU6-100 - Extra Frills Mustard

MU8-100 - Mizuna Mustard

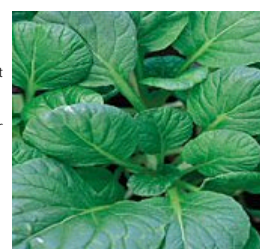
