Phyto - Phytosanitary Certificate

A Phytosanitary Certificate is required for seeds sent to Australia only in bulk quantities, and to Japan in any size quantity. Many other countries require a certificate so you should check with your customs office before placing your order. Orders sent to Japan also require a testing fee, before a certificate can be issued by the USDA.



TESTING - Phytosanitary Certificate Testing Fees

To obtain Phytosanitary Certificate that requires the seeds to be tested, you must pay the the testing fees. If you order five different types of seeds (cucumbers, eggplants, peppers, tomatoes, watermelons), then you would order a quantity of 5.
