67 days. Pisum sativum. Plant produces good yields of 4" long snap peas. Very flavorful. Pick snow peas before seeds start to develop inside. Excellent for stir fry. 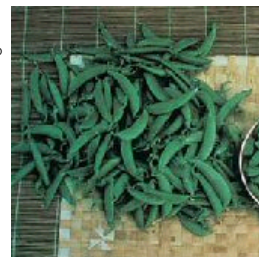
**PVP Variety**

95 days. Pisum sativum. Plant produces high yields of sweet snap peas. This variety is more productive than similar varieties. Suitable for home garden and market growers. The Super Sugar Snap is protected by the Plant Variety Protection Act, #9600007. United States Department of Agriculture, PI 591835 PVP. A variety developed in the USA. pk/50

**PE19-50 - Early Snap Peas**

58 days. Pisum sativum. Plant produces good yields of flavorful 3" long snap peas. The Early Snap Pea matures approximately 10 days earlier than the Sugar Snap Pea. Requires little or no staking. Disease Resistant: Bean Yellow Mosaic. Plant Height: 22" tall vines. pk/50



**PE22-50 - Sugar Daddy Snap Peas**

60 days. Pisum sativum. Plant produces good yields of flavorful snap peas. This variety produces good quality stringless pods! pk/50



**PE23-50 - Sugar Sprint Snap Peas**
