TL10-20 - Mexican Strain Tomatillo

65 days. *Physalis ixocarpa*. Plant produces heavy yields of flavorful 2" wide tomatillo. This tomatillo is larger than other varieties and has more savory flavor. Excellent for salsa verde and chili verde. Tomatillos are fully ripe when it falls from plant. Suitable for home garden and market growers. A variety from Mexico. pk/20



TL1-20 - Cisneros Tomatillo

75 days. *Physalis ixocarpa*. Plant produces incredibly large apple green color tomatillos. This variety is twice as large as other tomatillo. Excellent for making salsa. pk/20



TL12-20 - Tomatillo

70 days. *Physalis ixocarpa*. Plant produces heavy yields of flavorful green tomatillos. Tomatillos are fully ripe when it falls from plant. Very popular in the Southwest United States for making salsas when combined with fresh, hot peppers. Suitable for home garden and market growers. pk/20



TL13-20 - Grande Rio Verde Tomatillo

90 days. *Physalis ixocarpa*. Plant produces heavy yields of 3 oz green tomatillos. Mexican husk tomato for salsa verde. Tomatillos are fully ripe when it falls from plant. Very popular in the Southwest United States for making salsas when combined with fresh, hot peppers. Suitable for home garden and market growers. pk/20



TL14-20 - Mt Pima Tomatillo

NEW 65 days. *Physalis philadelphica*. Plant produces heavy yields of small tomatillo. Plant is sprawling. Excellent for salsa verde and chili verde. Tomatillos are fully ripe when it falls from plant. pk/20



TL15-20 - Zuni Tomatillo

NEW 65 days. *Physalis philadelphica*. Plant produces heavy yields of small tomatillo. Plant is sprawling. Excellent for salsa verde and chili verde. Tomatillos are fully ripe when it falls from plant. A variety from New Mexico, USA. pk/20



TL16-20 - Gigante Tomatillo

100 days. *Physalis ixocarpa*. Plant produces good yields of giant 4" diameter green tomatillos. This is the biggest tomatillo on the market. It is ripe when it falls from plant. Very popular in the Southwest United States for making salsas when combined with fresh, hot peppers. pk/20



TL17-20 - San Juanito Tomatillo

NEW 80 days. *Physalis philadelphica*. Plant produces good yields of extra large 3 oz green tomatillo. The fruit is covered with papery green husk. Excellent for salsa verde and chili verde. pk/20



TL18-20 - Dr Welch's Yellow Tomatillo

NEW 90 days. *Physalis philadelphica*. Plant produces heavy yields of yellow tomatillo. The fruit is covered with papery brown husk. Excellent for salsa verde and chili verde. A variety developed by the late Dr. John Wyche. pk/20



TL19-20 - Michoacan Tomatillo

65 days. *Physalis ixocarpa*. Plant produces good yields of Mexican tomatillo. Excellent for salsa verde and chili verde. Tomatillos are fully ripe when it falls from plant. Suitable for home garden and market growers. A variety from Mexico. pk/20



TL2-20 - Pineapple Tomatillo

70 days. *Physalis ixocarpa*. Plant produces good yields of tomatillos. It has a fruity taste that is similar to that of pineapple. Excellent for making a wonderful salsa. The small, cherry size fruit turn from green to yellow-gold when mature. They are surrounded by a papery husk that turns from green to brown as they ripen and splits open when they are ready to



TL3-20 - Purple Tomatillo

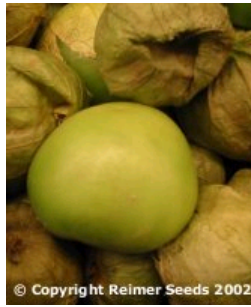
65 days. *Physalis ixocarpa*. Plant produces high yields of flavorful purple tomatillos. Excellent for making attractive salsa. A great storage type tomatillo. pk/20





TL4-20 - Toma Verde Tomatillo

60 days. Physalis ixocarpa. Plant produces good yields of large green tomatillos. Used to make salsa and other Mexican dishes. One of the early producing varieties. They are surrounded by a papery husk that turns from green to brown as they ripen and splits open when they are ready to harvest. pk/20



TL5-20 - Verde Puebla Tomatillo

75 days. Physalis ixocarpa. Plant produces excellent yields of 2" wide tomatillo. The green fruit is inside a tan papery husk. Very flavorful. Excellent for making salsa and other Mexican dishes. Indeterminate. Plant Height: 28" tall. pk/20



TL6-20 - Green Husk Tomatillo

90 days. Physalis ixocarpa. Plant produces excellent yields of 2" wide tomatillo. The green fruit is inside a green papery husk. The fruit are ripe when they burst through the husk. Mix with hot peppers to make Mexican green sauce. Also used to make salsa and other Mexican dishes. Washed thoroughly with mild soap to remove the sticky coating on the outside of the fruits. A variety from Mexico. Indeterminate. Plant Height: 48" tall. pk/20

TL8-20 - Purple de Milpa Tomatillo



70 days. Physalis ixocarpa. Plant produces good yields of small to medium size tomatillos. This variety was grown unattended in a corn fields by a family in Mexico. It stores fresh for several weeks. Excellent for making salsa. They are surrounded by a papery husk that turns from green to brown as they ripen and splits open when they are ready to harvest. A heirloom variety from Mexico. pk/20
