AS1 -20 - Mary Washington Asparagus

Asparagus officinalis. This perennial plant produces heavy yields of uniform sturdy tender stalks of dark green asparagus. One of the most popular varieties grown by home gardeners. A variety from the USA. United States Department of Agriculture, NSL 20542. pk/20



AS2-20 - UC 72 Asparagus

Asparagus officinalis. Plant produces heavy yields of dark green asparagus spears. It is usually larger than the Mary Washington variety. Disease Resistant: Fusarium Wilt. pk/20



AS3-20 - Jersey Giant Asparagus

F-1 Hybrid Variety

Asparagus officinalis. (F1) Plant produces heavy yields of large uniform stalks of dark green asparagus. An all male variety, which means every plant produces spears and not seeds, resulting in higher yields. A suggested replacement for the Mary Washington Asparagus. Disease Resistant: Fusarium Wilt. A variety from the USA. pk/20



AS4-20 - Jersey Knight Asparagus

F-1 Hybrid Variety

Asparagus officinalis. (F1) Plant produces heavy yields of large uniform stalks of dark green asparagus. An all male variety, which means every plant produces spears and not seeds, resulting in higher yields. Disease Resistant: Fusarium Wilt, Crown & Root Rot, Rust, Cercospora.
