[CL5-50 - Brilliant Celeriac](#)

110 days. Apium graveolens. Open Pollinated. Plant produces large round crisp white celery flavored roots. Interiors are white and flavorful. Excellent in soups, stews, and used for making vegetable juice. Shredded and used in salads with greens. Also called Rooted Celery. Stores well. Harvest late in summer. Excellent choice for home gardens. United States Department of Agriculture, G 32727.



[CL6-100 - Giant Prague Celeriac](#)

110 days. Apium graveolens. Open Pollinated. The plant produces large 2 to 5" round crisp white celery flavored roots. Excellent in soups and stews and used for making vegetable juice. Also shredded and used in salads with greens. Also called Rooted Celery. Stores well. An excellent choice for home gardens. An heirloom dating back to 1871.
