

Blue Hot Peppers

HP1175-10 - Black Cuban Pepper Seeds

100 days. Capsicum annuum. Open Pollinated. Black Cuban Pepper. The plant produces good yields of $\frac{3}{4}$ " long by $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide hot peppers. Peppers are hot, have thin flesh, grow upright, and turn from dark purple black to red when mature. The plant has purple green stems, purple leaves with a tint of green, and violet flowers. A beautiful ornamental plant. A variety from Cuba. Scoville Heat Units: 50,000.
