**HP1393-10 - Capsicum Baccatum USDA #439382 Hot Pepper (Paraguay)**

90 days. Capsicum baccatum. Plant produces good yields of 1" long by 3/4" wide hot peppers. Peppers are hot and turn from green to red when mature. Plant has green stems, green leaves, and white flowers. United States Department of Agriculture, PI 439382. A variety from Paraguay. pk/10



**HP1497-10 - Chaco Hot Pepper (Yellow)**

**NEW** 85 days. Capsicum chacoense. Plant produces good yields of 2" long by 1/2" wide hot peppers. Peppers are hot and turn from dark green to yellow orange when mature. Plant has green stems, green leaves, and white flowers. A variety from the Chaco Forest of Paraguay and Argentina. pk/10.



**HP1721-10 - Capsicum Baccatum USDA GRIF 15018 Hot Peppers**

95 days. Capsicum baccatum. Plant produces good yields of 1/2" long by 1/8" wide hot peppers. Peppers are very hot and turn from green, to green with black markings, to orange, to red when mature. Plant has green stems, green leaves, and white flowers. Common Name: WWCQ-200. United States Department of Agriculture, GRIF 15018. A variety from Caazapa, Paraguay. pk/10

**NEW** 100 days. Capsicum baccatum. Plant produces good yields of 1/2" long by 1/4" wide hot peppers. Peppers are hot and turn from green, to orange, to orange-red when mature. Plant has green stems, green leaves, and white flowers. Also known as Locote Kaavy and GRIF 14139. United States Department of Agriculture, PI 633751. A rare variety from Paraguari, Paraguay. pk/10

**HP311-20 - El Chaco Hot Pepper**

85 days. Capsicum annum. Plant produces good yields of 4" long by 3/4" wide hot peppers. Peppers are very hot and mature from yellowish-green, to orange, to red when mature. Plant has light green stems, light green leaves, and white flowers. A variety from the Paraguay River region. pk/20



**HP871-10 - Chaco Hot Peppers (Red)**

100+ days. Capsicum chacoense. Bush type plant produces good yields of tiny 1/2" long by 1/4" wide hot peppers. Peppers are very hot and turn from green, to green with black markings, to red when mature. Plant has green stems, green leaves, and white flowers. A variety from the Chaco Forest of Argentina and Paraguay. pk/10
