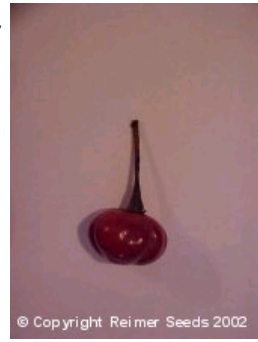
**HP1109- 10 - Capsicum Chinense USDA #281421 Hot Peppers**

90 days. Capsicum chinense. Plant produces good yields of 1/2" long by 1/4" wide hot peppers. Peppers grow upright and turn from green, to orange, to red when mature. Plant has green stems, green leaves, and yellowish-cream flowers. United States Department of Agriculture, PI 281421. A rare variety from Philippines. Plant Height: 66" tall. pk/10



**HP1263- 10 - Philippines Hot Pepper**

90 days. Capsicum annuum. Plant produces good yields of 1/2" long by 3/4" wide hot peppers. Peppers are hot and turn from green to dark red when mature. Plant has green stems, green leaves, and white flowers. A variety from Philippines. pk/10



**HP1531- 20 - Capsicum Annuum USDA #281416 Hot Pepper (Philippines)**

85 days. Capsicum annuum. Plant produces good yields of 2 1/4" long by 1 1/4" wide hot peppers. Peppers are hot and turn from light green to red when mature. Plant has green stems, green leaves, and white flowers. United States Department of Agriculture, PI 281416. A variety from the Philippines. pk/20



**HP899-20 - Sili-a-Top Hot Pepper (Philippines)**

95 days. Capsicum baccatum. Plant produces good yields of 5 1/2" long by 3/4" wide hot peppers. Peppers turn from light green, to light yellow, to orange when mature. Plant has green stems, green leaves, and white flowers with yellowish-green markings. United States Department of Agriculture, PI 188803. A variety from Philippines. pk/20
