CN46-50 - Black Aztec Corn Seeds

75 days. Zea mays. Open Pollinated. Black Aztec Corn. The plant produces high yields of beautiful 7 to 8" long blue-black corn. Used for making popcorn. Kernels pop white and tender. It makes half a bushel from one pound of kernels. Excellent variety for roasting and grinding into cornmeal. It's a good choice for cornmeal or flour. Also used for fall decorations. An excellent choice for home gardens and market growers. An heirloom variety dating back to the 1860s. United States Department of Agriculture, AMES 22636. A variety from the USA.
