Suitable for canning and freezing too! The Celebrity tomato plant is as close to perfect as you can get! One of the most disease-resistant tomato varieties. The plant has strong vines and does extremely well in most regions. Crack Resistant. To maximize yield potential, either stake or use cages. An excellent choice for home gardens and market growers. 56 days. *Pisum sativum*. Open Pollinated. Sugar Ann Snap Peas. This compact bush plant produces good yields of flavorful large 2 to 3" long snap peas. It is crisp, very sweet, and flavorful. Perfect for stir fry. Its short vines do not require trellising. The plant produces 10 to 14 days earlier than other varieties. Use fresh or cooked. Great freezing variety. Suitable for small home gardens and containers. Received the Award of Garden Merit from the Royal Horticultural Society. An excellent choice for home gardens.
