## CT21-750 - Kuroda Long Carrot Seeds

73 days. *Daucus carota*. Open Pollinated. Kuroda Long Carrot. The plant produces high yields of flavorful 8" long deep orange carrots. They are mild and sweet. Excellent for making carrot juice. Grows well in raised beds and compact spaces. A popular Asian market variety. It tolerates heat better than most carrots and does well in a wide variety of soils. Keeps well. Heat Tolerant. An excellent choice for home gardens, farmer's markets, and market growers. Disease Resistant: ALS.



## CT47-750 - Kyoto Red Carrot Seeds

90 days. *Daucus carota*. Open Pollinated. Kyoto Red Carrot. The plant produces good yields of 12" long bright red carrots. They are tender and sweet. Great when used fresh, steamed, or used to make carrot juice. Excellent for salads and gourmet dishes. Try growing orange, purple, red, white, and yellow carrots too for a beautiful gourmet dish. An excellent choice for home gardens. An heirloom variety is grown in the Kyoto area of Japan.



## CT37-250 - Samurai Red Carrot Seeds

75 days. *Daucus carota*. Open Pollinated. Samurai Red Carrot. The plant produces very flavorful 11" long deep red carrots. The carrots are crisp and retain a red color when steamed. Add color to your favorite dish by growing the white, purple, and yellow carrots. Great for gourmet dishes. An excellent choice for home gardens and specialty market growers. A variety from Japan.



## CT42-750 - Shin Kuroda Carrot Seeds

75 days. *Daucus carota*. Open Pollinated. Shin Kuroda Carrot. The plant produces good yields of 3 to 5" long bright orange carrots. These can be grown as baby carrots. Very flavorful. Excellent for making carrot juice. Stores well. Easy to harvest with their strong tops. It does well in a wide range of soil and weather conditions. Perfect for Asian specialty markets. An excellent choice for home gardens and market growers. A variety from Japan.
