

Sugar Cane

SC1-100 - Rox Orange Sugar Cane Seeds

110 days. Sorghum bicolor. Open Pollinated. Rox Orange Sugar Cane. The plant produces excellent yields of 8 ft tall sugar cane. The plant is high in sugar content. Perfect for making molasses syrup and an Asian alcoholic beverage called Maotai. Also grown and used as a biofuel and livestock grain. It yields about 100 gallons of syrup per acre. Does well in warm, well-drained, sandy loam. Also known as Waconia Sugar Cane. Sow 9 to 20 lbs per acre. An excellent choice for home gardens, market growers, and open field production. A variety was developed for syrup production by the Wisconsin Agricultural Experiment Station, Wisconsin, USA. United States Department of Agriculture, PI 641836.
