[MU11-100 - Crimson Tide Mustard](#)

48 days. Brassica juncea. Open Pollinated. The plant produces good yields of flavorful dark red mustard leaves. Excellent greens used in salads or cooked. Also used as a garnish. It retains intense leaf color even in the summer months. An excellent choice for home gardens.



[MU10-500 - Old Fashioned Mustard](#)

42 days. Brassica juncea. Open Pollinated. This early maturing plant produces good yields of flavorful bright green mustard leaves. Used in mixed green salads or cooked, either steamed or sauteed. High in Vitamin A, B, and C. Also known as Old Fashion Mustard, Hen Pecked Mustard and Ragged Edged Mustard. An heirloom variety. Excellent choice for home gardens. [MU9-500 - Tatsoi Improved Mustard](#)

55 days. Brassica juncea. Open Pollinated. The plant produces good yields of flavorful dark green spoon-shaped mustard leaves. This oriental vegetable forms dense leaves that can also be harvested as a whole plant and bunched. Used in mixed salads, soups, cooked, or stir-fries. Also known as Tah Tsai Mustard. Cold-Tolerant. Suitable for hydroponics gardening. Excellent choice for home gardens. United States Department of Agriculture, PI 662690.
