[RU1-100 - American Purple Top Rutabaga](#)

90 days. Brassica napus. Open Pollinated. Plant produces high yields of 4 to 6" diameter Rutabaga. It has purplish-red tops above ground and light yellow below ground. They are very sweet and flavorful. Flesh turns orange when cooked. Stores well. Prefers cool weather and is best grown as a fall crop. Excellent choice for home gardens. A heirloom dating back to the pre-1850s. United States Department of Agriculture, PI 675467.



[RU2-100 - Laurentian Rutabaga](#)

95 days. Brassica napus. Open Pollinated. The plant produces high yields of 4 to 6" diameter Rutabaga. It has a deep purple color above the ground and a creamy pale yellow color below the ground. Very sweet and flavorful. The most popular Rutabaga has grown today. It is an improved version of the American Purple Top Rutabaga. Stores well. Excellent choice for home gardens.
