RU1-100 - American Purple Top Rutabaga

90 days. Brassica napus. Open Pollinated. The plant produces high yields of 4 to 6" diameter Rutabaga. It has purplish-red tops above ground and light yellow below ground. They are very sweet and flavorful. Flesh turns orange when cooked. Stores well. Prefers cool weather and is best grown as a fall crop. Excellent choice for home gardens.
