

Peppers (Hot)

[HP2509-10 - Coban Orange Pepper Seeds](#)

85 days. Capsicum annuum. Open Pollinated. Coban Orange Pepper. This small plant produces good yields of 1" long by 3/4" wide hot peppers. Peppers are very hot, have thin flesh, grow upright, and turn from green to orange when mature. The plant has green stems, green leaves, and white flowers. Excellent drying pepper for making seasoning spice powder. It is similar to the Coban Pepper, but maturing to orange instead of red. A variety from Guatemala. Scoville Heat Units: 50,000.

[HP2184-10 - Diente de Perro Hot Peppers \(Type 3\)](#)

85 days. Capsicum annuum. Open Pollinated. The plant produces good yields of 3 1/4" long by 1/2" wide hot peppers. Peppers turn from green to red when mature. The plant has green stems, green leaves, and white flowers. A variety from Guatemala. United States Department of Agriculture PI 555636 Type 3. Scoville Heat Units: 48,000.
