Peppers are hot, have thin flesh, grow upright in clusters, and turn from green to red when mature. The plant has green stems, green leaves, and white flowers. Excellent for making hot sauce, hot pepper flakes, and seasoning spice powder. Suitable for containers. A rare variety from the Bahamas.
