## [CU11-20 - Lemon Cucumber Seeds](#)

65 days. Cucumis sativus. Open Pollinated. Lemon Cucumber. The plant produces heavy yields of 2 ½ to 4" round lemon-shaped cucumbers. They are tender and sweet, are never bitter, and are great for salads and pickling. Great for large containers! Does well in cool weather. Cold Tolerant. Drought Tolerant. Great specialty market salad item. Excellent choice for home gardens and specialty market growers. An 1894 heirloom variety from Australia. United States Department of Agriculture, NSL 106620.



## [CU128-10 - Richmond Green Apple Cucumbers](#)

70 days. Cucumis sativus. Open Pollinated. The plant produces high yields of 3" round lime green cucumbers with white flesh. These cucumbers are very mild, sweet, juicy, and crunchy. If you like Lemon cucumbers, you will also enjoy these slightly larger lime green cucumbers. Great for gourmet dishes. Excellent choice for home gardens and market growers.
