45 days. Brassica oleracea. Open Pollinated. This early maturing plant produces heavy yields of delicious blue-green collards. Perfect steamed, boiled, or stir-fried. Harvest young tender leaves for the best flavor. Slow to bolt in hot weather. Heat-Tolerant. Also known as Cabbage Collards. Traditional greens are grown in the South. Suitable for hydroponic gardening. Excellent choice for home gardens. An heirloom variety from the USA. United States Department of Agriculture, NSL 6154.
