### [SQ111-20 - Queensland Blue Squash Seeds](#)

120 days. Cucurbita pepo. Open Pollinated. Queensland Blue Squash The plant produces good yields of large 10 to 20 lb dark bluish-grey-green pumpkin-shaped squash. The squash is flattened and ribbed. Very flavorful. The orange flesh is meaty and sweet which is perfect for cooking. Stores well. This squash was introduced to the United States in 1932 by Arthur Yates & Company of Sydney. Australians love this squash and make pumpkin squash soup. An excellent choice for home gardens and specialty market growers. An heirloom variety from Australia. A winter squash variety.
